



GETTING TO GLAZIERS HALL

Glaziers Hall is located on the South Bank alongside London Bridge and near Southwark Cathedral, and is easily accessible by road, river and public transport.

For access by road via Tooley Street pass under the tunnel into Montague Close. The entrance is on your right hand side. Via Borough High Street turn into Bedale Street, then turn right onto Cathedral Street. Continue driving past the Cathedral then turn right again onto Montague Close. The entrance is on your left hand side.

If travelling via London Bridge underground station, take the 'Duke Street Hill' exit. Cross the road in front of you at the traffic lights and head towards London Bridge Hospital. Follow the pavement around the corner to the left. Continue under the tunnel and the entrance to Glaziers Hall is on your right.

For access via the Thames, on arrival at London Bridge City Pier turn right onto Queens Walk. Continue along the path behind London Bridge Hospital until you see the signpost above for Tooley Street. Turn left onto the pathway opposite the sign 'The Queens Walk', and you will reach Tooley Street. Turn right and continue under the tunnel. Glaziers Hall is on your right.
